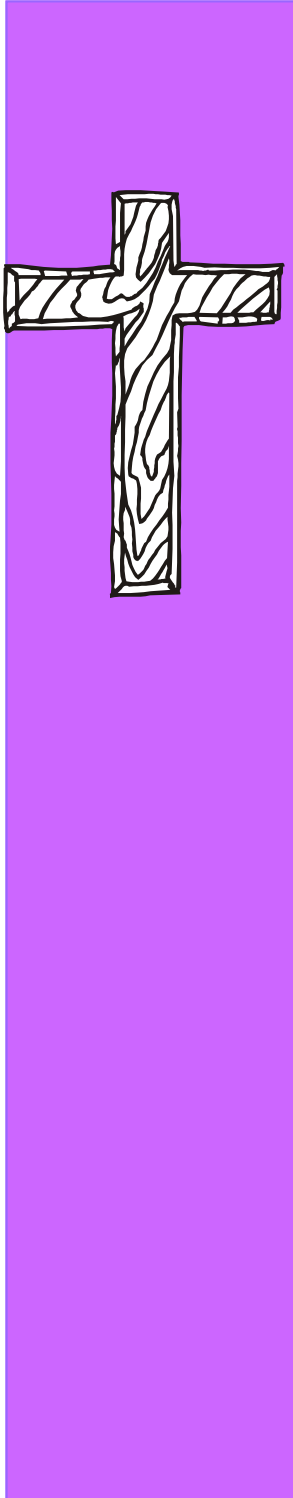

Fourth Week of Lent

Dear Friend,

Are you often pressed for time, not knowing what to do first and what to drop from your agenda? Who and what is important for you to devote your time to, your energy, your attention, your care?

When people get seriously ill and time –their precious life-time- seems to run out on them, they still want to clear up things, want to complete what has been left unfinished, but time keeps running relentlessly.

It happens to me sometimes: I am pressed for time and suddenly something is not possible anymore. What is necessary today? What can help me today to alleviate the fear that time is running out on me?

“A wise person was asked,
What is the most important hour of a human life;
who is the most important person one will meet,
what is be the most necessary work one has to do.
The answer was this:
The most important hour is always the present time,
The most important person is always the one
you are just encountering;
and the most important work to be accomplished
is always Love.” (*Meister Eckehart*)
