L: Mary, Comforter of the afflicted, you proclaimed that the mighty will be cast down and the lowly rose up. You stood in solidarity with Jesus at the Cross. You stood with him when His Resurrection broke the power of evil and death.

All: We pray for the fullness of the Gifts of Your Spirit, O Jesus.

L: Jesus Christ, Son of God, you call us to freedom. You smashed the reign of Satan and won for us eternal life. You promised to walk with us and to empower us to shatter the forces of

oppression with a love which no violence or hatred can withstand. Jesus, you are our Liberator and we pray with you.

L: Jesus, our brother and Lord,

All: You came into our darkness to drive away our fears of death. You told us to "fear not", for you would be with us. You told us we are precious, beyond the sparrows of the air and the lilies of the field. You spoke of our power to love one another and called us to love each other as you love us. Walk with our sisters and brothers as they struggle to move from darkness to light, from fear and repression to freedom. - L: Let us pray with faith in God and in the bloodshed by so many martyrs, in the words of Archbishop Romero: "The cry of liberation is a cry that reached up to God and one that nothing or no one can stop. Over these ruins, the glory of the Lord will shine."

With Mary, Our Blessed Mother we pray:

- I: Pilgrim sister of the Poor, Prophetess of the poor made free, Mother of the entire world. Mother of all in this world that is one because you are the Mother of God made human!
- II: With all those who believe in Christ, and with all those who in any way seek His Kingdom, we call on you, our Mother, to talk to Him for all of us.
- **I:** Ask Jesus who became poor to share with us the riches of His love, so that His church may strip herself from all other riches.
